CPUC Voting Meeting G-3605: Update

9/5/25

Another CPUC voting meeting with public comment on G-3605 (Southern California Gas Company's 2024 Compliance Plan, Forecasts, and Caps for Its Natural Gas Leak Abatement Program) or SB1371 is scheduled for 9/8/25 via phone line for public comment or viewable via webcast. A revision of resolution G-3605 has been submitted 8/28/25 for approval to the commission. Previously the Safety Policy Division (SPD) submitted for approval \$248,199,826 of the \$404,320,007 requested by SoCalGas. Out of the 26 chapters submitted SPD approved: Chapter 1, Leak Inventory Reduction, Chapter 3, Blowdown Reduction Activities, Chapter 7, Record Keeping IT Project, Chapter 7, Record Keeping IT Project, Chapter 8, Geographic Tracking, Chapter 13, Electronic Leak Survey, Chapter 14, Aerial Monitoring, Chapter 15, Damage Prevention Public Awareness, Chapter 16, Pipe Fitting Specifications, Chapter 19, Gas Speciation, Chapter 20, Public Leak Maps. Out of these Chapters the Energy Division (ED) only approved \$102,034,739 for Chapter 3, Blowdown Reduction Activities as of July and this was to be voted on for approval on the 8/28/25 CPUC voting meeting. During this meeting it was announced by the commission that it would be postponed to the 9/8/25 meeting due to a new revision, please see "[G-3605-CPUC-VOTE.pdf](#)" on our website for info on how to join the next call or see below. In the revision an added approval from SPD resulted in \$296,879,369 with Chapter 2, increased leak survey and 10, training facility enhancements. This is a significant improvement due to meetings/comments held with SPD and ED to get our point across as Local 132 Leadership has done this work with firsthand knowledge, we, like many of our members, know the benefits here. I was proud to see letters being sent in for support not only by our members but political leaders doing so as well and others staying on the call for its entirety. We at local 132 are asking for your support again to continue sending letters of support and leaving public comment for this resolution and show that public safety should priority second to none.
