



# **NEGOTIATIONS DAY-32 LOCAL 132**

**September 30, 2024**

Day 32 of negotiations has arrived, coinciding with the expiration of the Collective Bargaining Agreement. The Union and the Company have been exchanging counteroffers on wages and other key issues, with discussions continuing into the early hours of Tuesday, October 1.

The Union and the Company have agreed to extend the Collective Bargaining Agreement until Friday, October 4, 2024. This extension allows more time for continued negotiations and helps maintain forward momentum in the bargaining process.

All work activities will continue as usual, and all employees are expected to report to work as negotiations proceed. The focus remains on reaching a tentative agreement during the extended bargaining period.

There have been numerous inquiries from members regarding a potential strike. At this time, no strike is scheduled. If a strike is called, the Union will issue an official notice with the exact date and time it will begin. Please be mindful of misinformation and false documents that have been circulating. To ensure accuracy, verify any information through the Local 132 website or by consulting with a Union officer or steward.
