Dear UWUA 132 members,

The Organizing Department has been working tirelessly to protect our jobs, meeting with legislators and labor leaders to ensure UWUA Local 132 has strong support at the table with the CPUC and Maryam Brown.

Working alongside UWUA's lobbyist, organizers successfully circulated a delegation letter of support from lawmakers, voicing opposition to layoffs and branch office closures. As of September 5, 2025, signatures have been secured from both the Senate and Assembly floors. In addition, organizers have participated in several events to educate the public and promote our commitment to advancing hydrogen as part of a cleaner, safer, and more affordable energy future.

UWUA Local 132 does not have a budget for externally organizing at this time. Currently, the Organizing Committee is focusing on internal organizing and supporting the goals of Local 132 through outreach to external supporters to further our agenda, strengthen our Local, and our industry. To sustain these efforts and acquire funds to support external organizing in the future, the Organizing Committee has applied for grants with the AFL-CIO and The LIFT Fund to help secure the needed resources.

Moving forward, organizers remain committed to building strong local support, working collaboratively with legislators, labor leaders, and community allies to protect jobs and ensure a stronger future for all.
